

Father Christian Tutor is a Priest and Religious of the Diocese of the Northeast of the Anglican Church in America. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in English Literature and Writing and Philosophy, as well as a Master Degree in Theology in Pastoral and Spiritual Care, as well as Graduate Certification in Pastoral Care. He Professed Solemn Religious Vows in July 1993, and renewed them in September 2006. Father Christian was Ordained Deacon on February 2, 2007, and Ordained to the Priesthood on August 4, 2007.

He is currently Rector of the Parish of All Saints in Concord, New Hampshire, and serves his Diocese as *Safe Environment Coordinator* and as *Marriage Tribunal Judge*. Since 2009 he has held the position of *Canon Liturgist* in which he directs all the major liturgical events for the Diocese, as well as run seminars and retreats that focus on liturgy and liturgical practice.

Father Tutor is *Secretary* of the Board of New Hampshire Right to Life, and holds the position of *Chair of the Educational Trust Fund* for the same. He travels throughout the State of New Hampshire implementing the goals of NHRTL in providing education opportunities promoting Life from conception to natural death.
